If you were not able to get your pledge information to the church, we are still collecting pledge cards for the next week or so. There are also pledge cards available at church.

We have received 16 pledges that pledged a total of \$79,380 towards our church expenses and ministries for 2021. An additional \$3000 was pledged towards the lease-to-own printer payments and \$1560 was pledged towards debt reduction on the church building. In 2019, we received 28 pledges for a total of \$120,560. We could still use more pledges as council begins the process to develop a budget for 2021. The Advent and Christmas Seasons

We begin this new church year the way we ended things last March......in disruption.

When this pandemic began in the spring, we thought we could handle the two or three weeks it would take to subdue the virus— but the virus had other plans. Now we find ourselves many months later still in disruption in every aspect of our lives.

Our Advent wreath this year will reflect this disruption in our plans for the Advent and Christmas seasons: no perfectly coordinated candles and liturgies, rather using what we already have on hand to remind us of the Light coming into the Darkness. Our wreath may be a symbol of our disruption...but the Light hasn't changed. Join us this Sunday as we light the second candle

During the Advent Season, and in keeping with the disruption we are all feeling, we are asking our members to bring in sturdy candleholders of all types with your name on the bottom so they can be returned after Christmas. We are also asking you to bring in your used, mismatched, or broken candles of all colors and shapes. The candles need to be unscented and will not be returned. There will be a container in the narthex where these items will be collected. Thank you for your participation.

Future Worship Services

As our Covid-19 numbers continue to rise in Weber County and in Utah, we want to emphasize the importance of everybody following the safety protocols we have implemented. Based on member feedback, we will continue with in-person and online worship services throughout the Advent and Christmas seasons unless the risk becomes too great. It is anticipated that we will have at least two worship services on Christmas Eve, giving enough room to social distance. More information on registration for Christmas Eve Services will be available soon. Covid-19 safety protocols are as follows:

- Encourage those that are at risk or those who are unsure, to remain at home
- If you have a cough, sore throat, fever, or other symptoms, do not come to church
- Emphasize that even with precautions, we are not able to eliminate all the risk
- Since we need to tape a full service at church anyway, let those who want to be at church attend as we tape the service
- There will be 6 feet between family groups you must wear a mask at all times inside the church
- We will not say prayers aloud follow along with your heart in silence
- We will not sing aloud sing in spirit
- Continue to post the service online on YouTube and continue to use Facebook Live
- Please respect everybody's decision to worship as they feel comfortable to do

So now we wait for the forgiveness calculation, reconsideration, final submission and Zions Bank approval. This process could take up to 90 days before Small Business Administration approval is received.
