For those interested in the origin of our first reading; (from Wikipedia)

The **Book of Sirach** (<u>/ˈsaɪræk/</u>)^[a] or **Ecclesiasticus** (<u>/ɪˌkliːziˈæstɪkəs/</u>; abbreviated **Ecclus.**)^[3] is a Jewish work, originally in Hebrew, of ethical teachings, from approximately 200 to 175 BCE, written by the <u>Judahite</u> scribe <u>Ben Sira</u> of <u>Jerusalem</u>, on the inspiration of his father Joshua son of Sirach, sometimes called Jesus son of Sirach or Yeshua ben Eliezer ben Sira.

Sirach is accepted as part of the <u>canon</u> by <u>Catholics</u>, <u>Eastern Orthodox</u>, and most <u>Oriental Orthodox</u> Christians. The <u>Anglican</u> tradition considers Sirach (which was published with other Greek Jewish books in a separate section of the <u>King James Bible</u>) among the apocryphal books, and read them "for example of life and instruction of manners; but yet [do] not apply them to establish any doctrine." The <u>Lutheran</u> Churches take a similar position.
