

Local Food Pantry Visits

Sunday School students and Ascension members visited the Tri-City Exchange Food Pantry in North Ogden this past Wednesday to deliver food items; tour their food pantry and present a \$300 check from the Noisy Offering. Mike and his staff described all the smaller local food pantries and school districts that receive food and support from his location. They have food available on the shelf on Tuesday and Thursdays, but on Friday, they give out several boxes of food to almost 2000 people.

Our next food pantry trip will be Sunday, November 23rd at 11:30 am as we tour the Martha's Food Pantry at Griffin Memorial Church of God in Christ located at 2424 South E Street. The food pantry provides food weekly and has been a blessing to many. It has also bridged cultural gaps and transcended language barriers, as their church building is located in West Ogden, which is heavily populated with Spanish-speaking residents.
