CHRISMON ORNAMENTS

The Christmas tree in the sanctuary at Ascension Lutheran Church is decorated with handmade ornaments called Chrismons. "Chrismon" is a combination of the words "Christ" and "monogram," and means "symbols of Christ." Chrismons are gold and white, representing majesty and purity. They were first developed in 1957 by Frances Kipps Spencer of Ascension Lutheran Church in Danville, Va.

Early Christians often worshipped in secret to avoid possible persecution and death. They developed certain symbols that were used to communicate with fellow believers and direct Christians to secret places of worship. Symbols that signified the believers' faith often adorned doors and buildings and were included on items such as jewelry and household utensils. These centuries-old symbols, and other pictorial representations from the Bible and church history, are the inspiration for Chrismons that adorn Chrismon trees in churches of different denominations throughout the country.

You are invited to spend a few moments this Advent season looking at the tree and reflecting on the Chrismons and their meaning. A few you will notice include:

- · Butterfly: The butterfly is a symbol of Christ's resurrection and eternal life. Just as the butterfly emerges from its cocoon and flies upward with a new body, the followers of Jesus Christ are reborn and given a new life.
- · Chi Rho: The Chi Rho Chrismon is a monogram of the first two letters of the Greek word from Christ Chi (X) and Rho (P).
- · Fish: The fish is a popular symbol of Christianity today. It was a secret symbol used by the early persecuted Christians to signify their belief in Jesus.

If you are interested in learning about the other symbols, there is a printed sheet with the symbols and their meaning in the Narthex (Lobby).

My name is DanaLee Simon and I am a Pastor in the UT Conference of ELCA Churches. I am excited to lead our second annual Women's Christmas Retreat on Saturday, January 10, 2026 from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. We will gather at Our Savior's Lutheran (2500 E 3900 S, Holladay, UT 84124) and I would love for you to come.

Our theme this year, *Wise Women Also Came*, will once again be based on a resource by pastor, poet and author, Jan Richardson. I love her explanation of what a Women's Christmas celebration is all about. "There is a custom, rooted in Ireland, of celebrating Epiphany (January 6, which brings the Christ-mas season to a close) as Women's Christmas. (It) originated as a day when the women, who often carried the domestic responsibilities all year, took Epiphany as an occasion to celebrate together at the end of the holidays. . . , Whether your domestic commitments are many or few, Women's Christmas offers an opportunity to pause and step back from whatever has kept you busy and hurried in the past weeks or months. As the Christmas season ends, this is an occasion both to celebrate with friends and also to spend time in reflection before diving into what this new year will hold."

It is in this spirit that we will come together. We will begin by sharing brunch, and then dive more deeply into our theme, together, through art, poetry, music, prayer, and connective conversation. I look forward to seeing you and connecting us all together in this fun and meaningful gathering.

The registration fee for this retreat is \$30. Scholarships are available. Please let Pastor DanaLee know if you are in need of one.
