ALC Council Declares CLC Gutter Repair an Emergency

On June 2, 2024, at an ALC Congregational Meeting, the following resolution was adopted:

Whereas, the CLC Building is more than twenty years old;

Whereas, the children served in KidzTown cannot be without heat, air conditioning, or other vital services for three weeks or longer;

Whereas, it takes approximately three weeks to hold a Congregational Meeting once the Council learns of a problem;

Whereas, the Ascension Constitution requires a Congregational Meeting for any expenditure over \$6,000.00.

Be it therefore resolved that, only when expenditures greater than \$6,000.00 are related to emergency repairs and/or replacements in the CLC Building, the Church Council may move forward with needed decisions without holding a Congregational Meeting.



The Council was made aware that the gutters on the KidzTown playground side, located on the north side of the CLC Building, were hanging from the roof into the playground area, creating a hazard for the children. The situation was compounded by heat tape attached to the gutter to prevent large icicles from forming. After checking with the company that installed the heat tape, the Council learned that Ascension's warranty on the heat tape would be invalid if it was removed improperly. Jim Craig obtained bids for the work, and the Council determined that Intermountain Seamless Gutter's bid should be accepted after confirming that using this company would ensure the warranty remained in place. Jim Craig has contacted the company, and repairs are scheduled to begin on October 1. In the meantime, KidzTown is using the CLC gym for many physical education activities.

Financial summary: The total cost of the work is \$12,045.00, and a deposit of \$4,215.75 has been sent to schedule the work.
