As our Covid-19 numbers rise in Weber County and in Utah, the Ascension Church Council has re-evaluated our worship service procedures and made a determination to continue in-person worship in a limited fashion. It was decided to do the following:

1. Encourage those that are at risk or who are unsure, to remain at home
2. If you have a cough, sore throat, fever, or other symptoms, do not come to church
3. Emphasize that even with cautions, we are not able to eliminate all the risk
4. Since we need to tape a full service at church anyway, let those who want to be at church attend as we tape the service
5. Continue to post the service online and continue to use Facebook Live
6. Please respect everyone's decision to worship as they feel comfortable to do
