### PPP Loan Forgiveness

As mentioned on Christmas Eve, the Small Business Administration (SBA) informed us that our Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) loan forgiveness was approved in full. The loan of \$13,100 has been fully forgiven by both Zions Bank and the SBA. As we look at end-of-year finances and the requirements for 2021 PPP loans, council will determine whether we come back to the congregation with a proposal to apply for another PPP loan.
