The Jr. and Sr. High Sunday school classes have been continuing online since March 2020. Over the summer, links were sent to the students on Christian-based videos and we met in Zoom sessions, periodically. Since fall, we have been discussing books, with a chapter each week.

The first book was A SHEPHERD LOOKS AT THE 23RD PSALM, by P. Fuller. We enjoyed this author's experience as a shepherd and how he related good shepherding of sheep to Jesus's good shepherding of us. Just like sheep, we go astray and the Good Shepherd just continues to call us back.

Our current book is GOD AND THE PANDEMIC by N. T. Wright, a professor at Oxford and a former bishop in the Anglican Church of England. Wright reflects on the Christian and the coronavirus with its aftermath. He draws from the Old Testament, as he looks at the prayers of lament by Job, and follows up with the New Testament and our response as called Christians.
