Council Update: Thank you to all those who volunteer and donate towards our church projects and needs!!

1. Patti Hall was approved as the replacement for Nancy Gale's council position.

2. Pat Refsdal was approved as the incoming Financial Secretary.

3. Sharen Kamp has volunteered to oversee our Stewardship Campaign for this fall.

4. Ascension youth are using the CLC Gym for weekly basketball practice.

5. Two other community teams have inquired about use of the gym.

6. Jim Craig has collected three bids to repair the stucco on the lower 4 feet of the ALC, as well as repair around the windows. Future discussions will involve selection of a contractor and beginning a Capital Campaign.

7. Jim Craig will again oversee the installation of two air conditioners and one furnace by Mountain Air Heating on the west side of the building. Scheduled for Aug 24-27.

8. Gods Work Our Hands T-Shirts were ordered and should arrive in time for GWOH Sunday.

9. Ascension sent Lutheran World Relief \$237 for the 88 LWR Personal Care Kits we shipped to them in May. This will provide for toothpaste and shipping to countries in need.

10. A church member has donated towards the purchase of one of the church air conditioners that will be installed in the coming weeks.

11. There are a couple of seats remaining at the Ascension table for the Family Promise Rise and Shine Breakfast Fundraiser scheduled for September 16th at 7:30 AM.

12. Zion's Bank has approved our PPP Loan Application for Forgiveness of the \$16,800 loan received in April. We expect the Small Business Administration approval in the coming week.

13. Planning for food, games, bounce house, fishing pond and trivia continues in preparation for Rally Day slated for August 22.

14. We want to welcome all ages to participate in dinner, a bible study, discussion, music and other activities as we begin Faith Formation Wednesdays beginning Sep 8th.

15. Council is considering a proposed youth fundraiser where we would team-up with a company that provides pumpkins to sell. We would create a pumpkin patch that would be open Mon - Sat, from 11:30AM to 7:30PM for the last two weeks of October. More discussion to follow.
