

**We have refinanced the Community Life Center!** During the Synod Assembly, James and Sharen reached out and began a discussion with the Mission Investment Fund of the ELCA. If you don't know the mission of MIF, check out their website <https://www.mif.elca.org/>.

Here's part of what you will find;

"As the lending ministry of the ELCA, we understand the mission of your congregation or ministry — and your unique needs. We specialize in church building projects so we bring a depth of knowledge and experience to those projects. We offer competitive rates and terms. But the most beautiful part of borrowing with MIF is knowing that the interest you pay on your loan helps fund loans to other ELCA congregations and ministries, so they, too, can share God's love."

This week, Sharen has sent the documents in to refinance the loan that we currently have with Zion's bank. Our agreement with MIF requires us to keep our loan information confidential from outside parties, (so I won't print it here), but we can share with you that we have a lower interest rate, and our payments will go from about \$3200 per month to \$2970. That decrease will give us \$2760 a year added to our budget. We will continue with debt reduction as there is no penalty for early payments.
