


Please join us for the potluck luncheon following worship today.



Recently, we celebrated our generous donors after 5 years of serving families experiencing homelessness. Despite enthusiastic support from a dedicated core of community members, we were \$60,702 short of our goal. **We are asking for your help as a past supporter to help us achieve our goal of \$125,000 by the end of the year!**

There is no better way to **directly contribute** to the welfare of the most vulnerable Utahns in crisis

Over the past year, the problem of homelessness in our Utah communities has been amplified. The approaching winter months present an additional challenge for those already facing this mammoth obstacle, and it is particularly daunting for some of the most vulnerable victims of homelessness, **families with children**. Homelessness is a traumatic event for young children, and the negative mental and physical effects follow them throughout their lives.

Your donation to Family Promise of Ogden supports **lasting change** that echoes throughout lives and generations

When families stay with Family Promise of Ogden, **they are receiving the most cost-effective care available**. While traditional shelters spend **\$155/night** for basic help and transition **40%** of clients into stable housing, we spend only **\$86/night** for intensive case management and connection to community resources and since 2020, have supported **82% of residents into sustainable living situations**, making our program over **2 times as effective at facilitating long-term solutions for a little over half the cost**.

Our model at Family Promise of Ogden is unique across the Northern Utah prioritizes **long-term results** from the very beginning. While many organizations addressing homelessness provide a breadth of immediate resources to people in many different situations, we hone in on families with children as a particularly vulnerable group and strive to help them cultivate self-sufficiency through our intensive program **in addition** to meeting their basic needs.
