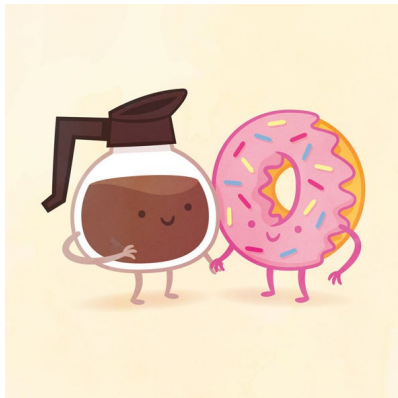

Washington Blvd Resurfacing We've received notification from UDOT that a resurfacing of SR-235 (Washington Blvd.) between 400 North and 2600 North will begin Monday, May 1st. They will begin replacing sidewalk pedestrian ramps along the road during daytime hours. Road signs will be upgraded, and a new concrete platform will be installed at the UTA bus stop located near the southwest corner of Washington Blvd and 2550 North. Road resurfacing will take place nightly through late June, Sunday through Thursday, between the hours of 7 p.m. and 5 a.m. Expect lane closures and reduced speeds. A brochure with additional information and a map of the affected area may be found on the bulletin board in the Fellowship Hall.

Congregation and Building Safety- Many people think of a house of worship as a safe area where violence and emergencies cannot affect them. We would all like to think that a church's doors should be open for all in need, whenever they need. But in today's environment, we need to be cautious and proactive about the safety of our members; the community that uses our facilities; and our buildings and grounds. Our church leadership has addressed several minor cases of vandalism on the church property and non-members who wanted access to our buildings when they are not open to the public. As a reminder to all who use the church building during non-worship hours:

- If you are alone in the building, do not grant access to any non-member who asks to come in. Our inclination is to help, but this is for your own safety.
- If others are present in the building, and you have a non-member asking for access, seek help from Pastor or church leadership.
- If alone or in a small group, keep the front door locked unless you expect others or need the door open for other reasons.
- Any questions, see a council member or Pastor.
