Shrove Tuesday is the day before Ash Wednesday, also known as **Fat Tuesday and Pancake Day**. Shrove comes from the word *shrive*, which referred to the confession of sins that was customary in the European Middle Ages as preparation for Lent. Shrove Tuesday is the last day before the beginning of the Lenten season of fasting leading up to Easter. Over the centuries, different cultures have developed creative ways of celebrating Shrove Tuesday—almost all involve festivities related to food and drink. These practices evolved as a way to use up “luxury” ingredients such as eggs and flour and sweets – things that likely might be given up in Lent. It is still observed in many Christian countries by participating in confession and absolution, the ritual burning of the previous year's Holy Week palms, finalizing one's Lenten sacrifice, and eating pancakes and other sweets.
