Our 2025 Lenten Ministry Ascension Lutheran Church Ogden, Utah



This year during Lent, we will be partnering with Youth Impact of Ogden to plan some fun Lenten Projects for the kids and the families that participate in the Youth Impact Program, located in a large, updated facility at 2305 Grant Ave, in Downtown Ogden.

Youth Impact's purpose is to respect, protect, serve and instill hope in the children of Ogden, and through them, our community. Their mission is to give each and every child who comes through their doors a safe place to learn, socialize and realize who they are and who they can become.

Since 1992 Youth Impact Ogden has been serving youth who reside in the Ogden community. The program started with a handful of young people who needed a safe place and has continuously grown over the years with new faces coming on a regular basis.

Their daily program consists of transporting participants from over 30 schools in the Ogden and Weber School Districts with 21 passenger vans. A variety of quality programs are also provided to the participants. Notable areas of the program are the Learning Center, Reading Room, Study Hall, Arts & Crafts, STEM, Recreational Sports, Ballet, Music Room, the outdoor garden, Food Pantry, staff offices and one-on-one daily mentoring of the youth. A home-cooked meal is prepared every evening by our in-house chef and participants who are part of the culinary program. At the end of a fun and eventful day, participants are given a ride home to their front door and made sure they are safely in their homes.

Beginning March 5th – March 16th, Ascension will be collecting jars of spaghetti or marinera sauce; canned meats such as chicken, beef, pork, tuna, Spam-type products, small canned ham, hash, chili, etc. We will also collect fresh fruit such as apples, oranges, grapes, bananas, blueberries, etc. We will have a separate basket for Youth Impact and the produce will be delivered to Youth Impact on each Monday morning.


The following two weeks of Lent, we will assemble various care kits for children in precarious situations. More information will be forthcoming.
