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Welcome to Worship...


Welcome to all God's guests, including those who call themselves "members" of this church named Ascension Lutheran Church more than 50 years ago.

P Know this:


There is a spring of life that flows throughout creation and is available to all – to us – when we need it most.


A Reading from The Revelation, the 21st chapter



P Jesus Christ become peace with you.


